



Rick Durante is Vice President, Director of Corporate Social Responsibility & Government Affairs at Franklin Mint Federal Credit Union, Executive Director of FMFCU Foundation and serves on the Board of Managers and Executive Director of Credit Union Network for Financial Literacy, LLC (CUNFL).
